Instructions for Poster Presentations

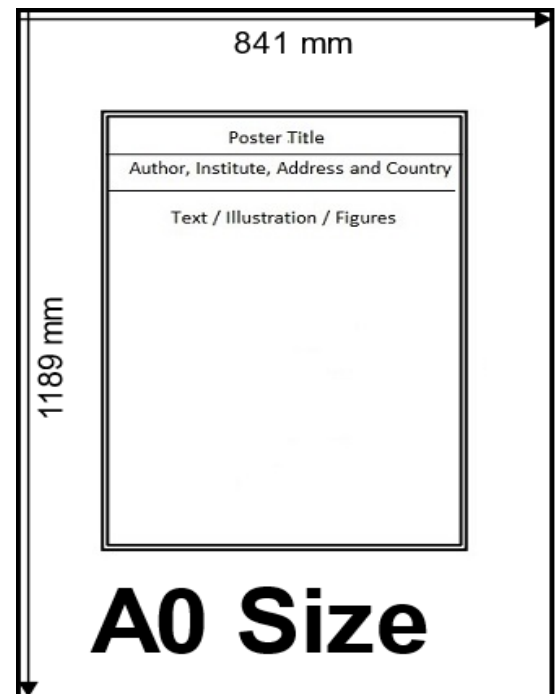
The following guidelines will be of help when you prepare your poster presentation. Please remember that it is very important that you prepare your poster **before** you travel to Seoul and that you bring it yourself. Do not mail your poster.

Poster Specification

Poster Size:

- Posters must be designed and prepared as a **single** poster of A0 paper size, with 841 mm wide and 1189 mm high (33.1 x 46.8 inches) (portrait).
- The following table gives width x height for A0 paper sizes in pixels in portrait orientation for specified resolutions from 72 PPI to 300 PPI.

Size	72 PPI	96 PPI	150 PPI	300 PPI
A0	2384 x 3370	3179 x 4494	4967 x 7022	9933 x 14043



Preparing your poster

Text on poster:

- Use a clear typeface and, if possible, a laser printer.
- The poster should be readable from a distance of 2-3 meters. This means that all lettering should be at least 8mm high, with a minimum font size of 24.
- The heading of the poster should list the paper title, author(s) name(s), and affiliation(s).

Graphs and diagrams:

- Graphs and figures should be readable from a distance of 2-3 meters.
- They should be drawn with a minimum line width of 1 mm.

Poster-session

Duration of the Presentation:

- Each session has 30 minutes. All Poster authors are kindly requested to be present at their poster during the entire session. The Poster session will be held to enable poster presenters to showcase their work. All delegates are invited to walk around the poster area to view the posters and to enter into lively and challenging discussions with the poster presenters.

Poster Set-Up:

- Posters may be attached to the boards by push pins, which will be provided.
- Posters must be set up by presenters 10 minutes before the session starts.
- Posters must be removed by presenters immediately after the session is over.
- Posters that have not been taken down by the authors in time will be removed by the organization and destroyed.
